## Migrant Student Services College Assistance Migrant Program

## VERIFICATION OF MIGRANT OR SEASONAL FARMWORKER

In order to be eligible for services provided by the College Assistance Migrant Program (CAMP), under the guidelines established by the U.S. Department of Education, a student who themselves or whose immediate family must have worked at least 75 days within the last two years in agriculture as a migrant or seasonal farmworker. This includes any activity directly related to the production of crops, dairy products, poultry, or livestock for commercial sale or personal subsistence, cultivation or harvesting of trees, or fish farms.

Or, be eligible to participate, or have participated, in programs under Title I Part C, No Child Left Behind Act of 2001, as amended by the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965, or WIA, of 1998 program.
